

Wim J.D. Gohres LL.M.

Board member of the Dutch Association of Tax Advisers (NOB) until 21 June 2018
Chair of the NOB Professional Affairs Committee until 21 June 2018.

Wim Gohres studied civil and tax law at the University of Leiden in the Netherlands. After that, he worked for more than 4 years as an income and corporate tax inspector. Wim began working as a tax adviser in 1988 for one of the Big 4 firms and switched to what is now PwC in 1995, where he was a tax partner until some years ago. He also edited various loose-leaf publications on pensions and has authored various other publications. He chairs a foundation responsible for education on tax law.

With the introduction of anti-money laundering legislation he became involved in the implementation and discussions with the legislator and the regulator on behalf of the Dutch Association of Tax Advisers (NOB). As a result he became primarily involved in anti-money laundering, compliance, auditor independence, risk and quality issues within his firm and the NOB. He is on a Netherlands state commission that advises on anti-money laundering legislation and implementation.

He has been a member of the Professional Affairs Committee of the NOB since its formation in 2006, and has been its chair since 2009. This will end as he steps down as NOB Board member, after which he will remain a member of NOB PAC.

As of 2010 he is a member of the Board of the NOB, in the latter years as a member of the executive board. He will step down as a board member in June 2018 due to statutory rotation. Within the board he is responsible for the admission committee, for the NOB PAC and for the bureau of NOB. He also has represented the NOB in the Confederation Fiscal Européenne (CFE) since 2012.
