Wim J.D. Gohres LLM

Wim Gohres has been a CFE Executive Board member and Chair of the CFE Professional Affairs Committee since 1 January 2017. He was reelected on this position at the CFE General Assembly in September 2018 with a mandate until the end of 2020.

Wim began working as a tax adviser in 1988 for the Big 4 and switched to what is now PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) in 1995, where he was a tax partner. At PwC and NOB, Wim is responsible for risk and quality issues, mandatory disclosure, anti-money laundering, compliance and auditor independence among other issues.

Wim was also a Board member of the Dutch Association of Tax Advisers (NOB) and Chair of the NOB Professional Affairs Committee until June 2018, when he stepped down due to statutory rotation. He has represented the NOB in the CFE since 2012. He has been a member of the Professional Affairs Committee of the NOB since its formation in 2006, and was its chair from 2009 to June 2018. He is still a member of this committee. Within the NOB Board Wim is responsible for the admission committee, for the NOB professional standards and for the bureau of NOB.

Wim studied civil and tax law at the University of Leiden, the Netherlands and worked for more than four years as an income and corporate tax inspector. He chairs a foundation responsible for education on tax law and sits on a Netherlands' state commission that advises on anti-money laundering legislation and implementation. Wim has edited and authored various loose-leaf publications on pensions and other matters.
