Ian E Hayes is a Tax Practitioner of over 40 years standing, during which time he has advised on all taxes, direct and indirect. His clients have included individuals, global and national corporate entities, charitable bodies, public authorities and government.

His interests are regulation, governance, taxpayer rights and the use of technology in tax. He is one of the three joint authors of Towards Greater Fairness in Taxation, A Taxpayer Charter and now is devoting some of his time to the growth of tax capacity in developing Countries.

Currently he continues to write and advise in the area of indirect tax, especially VAT applicable to property, international and intra EU trade and charitable bodies. He was National Tax Partner for Armitage and Norton, VAT Partner for Buzzacott and founder of Fiscal Solutions Ltd and Vatax Reclaim Ltd, both bespoke VAT Consultancies. He owns European Fiscal Services Ltd, a company which advises on the use of software in tax, particularly VAT. He was the CFE representative member of the EU VAT Forum from 2013 to 2018.

Until 2015 he represented London as an elected member of the Council of ICAEW and currently is a Council Member of the Chartered Institute of Taxation. From 2007 to 2012 he was a Board director of the Institute of Indirect Tax.

His involvement in the development of the tax profession over the last 20 years has included being Chairman of the Tax Faculty of ICAEW, Chairman of the Tax Technical Committee of ICAEW and Chairman of the Business Law Committee of ICAEW.

Prior to becoming a member of the Executive Board of CFE Tax Advisers Europe, he was the representative of the ICAEW on the General Assembly of CFE. In 2011/12 he was Chair of the Professional Affairs Committee and from 2013 to 2018 Vice-President of CFE.

Ian is now Chair of the CFE Tax Technology Committee and a member of the Board.
