CFE Tax Advisers Europe is pleased to announce the 2020 *Albert J. Rädler Medal Award*. CFE Tax Advisers Europe is a Brussels-based umbrella association representing European tax advisers. Founded in 1959, CFE brings together 33 national organisations from 26 European countries, representing more than 200,000 tax advisers. CFE is part of the European Union Transparency Register no. 3543183647-05.

CFE launched this process in 2013 to encourage academic excellence among young tax students and to commemorate the late tax adviser and Professor Albert J. Rädler (1933 – 2012).

We welcome applications from tax students who fulfil the following criteria:

- Master's dissertation by a student having achieved distinction in the relevant calendar year (2020/2021) on topics of European Taxation (taxation policy or tax law).
- Young students: The prize shall be awarded to a student aged 30 years or under on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021.
- Language requirements: dissertation written in English or translated into English.
- Application: Please send a PDF of your dissertation alongside an updated CV indicating your date of birth.
- Deadline: to be submitted by **15 March 2021** via email.
- Award: The Medal winner will be announced at the Online CFE Forum on 06 May 2021, our flagship international tax conference and the official award ceremony will take place at the CFE Professional Affairs Conference on 03 December 2021 in Zagreb.
- The CFE shall arrange travel and accommodation for the successful candidate: an economy flight, one night accommodation in Zagreb, free access to the CFE conference and complimentary academic literature from our publishing partner IBFD.
